RECOMMENDED DAILY FEEDING GUIDE (feeding amount per day)

For best results it is recommended that you weigh the food in ounces on a digital scale. If you do not have a scale, you may use the general estimate that one 8oz cup is approx. 8oz in weight. Always weigh your cat every 1-2 weeks and adjust initial servings accordingly when starting any new diet.
