Tips for Feeding Fresh Whole Foods

- **Safest Defrosting Method:** Slow defrost in the refrigerator.
- **Express Defrost:** Defrost under running cold water.
- **AVOID** keeping food in hot water, hot cars and on countertops.
- **Proteins:** Good for up to 5 days in refrigerator in an open package with the exception of fish.
- **Fish:** Good for up to 3 day in the refrigerator in an open package.
- **The Nose Knows:** If the recipe smells distinctly different after a few days, it's best to start fresh.
- **Picky Eater? No Appetite?** Return the unfinished bowl to the fridge within 20 minutes.
